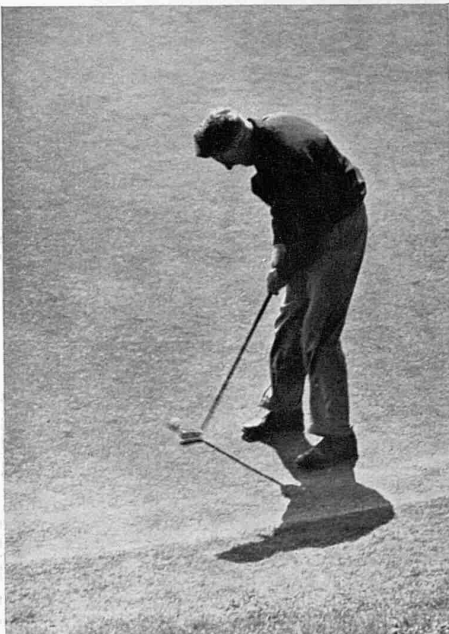


## English County Championships—continued from page 189.
