## MARBURY HALL COUNTRY CLUB, CHESHIRE—BY "MEL"

The Marbury Hall Country Club, which is situated some seven miles from Warrington and three miles from Norwich, is a splendid club which provides golf, lawn tennis, fishing and sailing. It also possesses a very fine open-air swimming-pool, set in beautiful surroundings. The golf-course is of the flat type, with good fairways providing a stiff test of the game. The Hall itself, designed in the early part of the 19th century by the famous architect, Salvin, belonged at one time to the Earl of Barrymore. The Mere, something like 100 acres in extent, is excellent for sailing and is said to possess the best coarse fishing in Cheshire. Marbury is a distinctly beautiful and romantic spot, and the 700 members can boast of having a club which for amenities and surroundings it would be difficult to beat. The managing director of the Club is Mr. George Smith and Lord Delamere is the President
