## TOLLEY BEATEN IN SOUTH AFRICA.

JOHANNESBURG, MONDAY.

Cyril Tolley and Captain A. G. Pearson were beaten by Captain T. G. McClelland, the South African champion in 1925, and Matthews by three and two in a match against Transvaal amateurs here to-day. In the other four-ball game R. H. de Montmorency and Major C. O. Hezlet defeated Ogilvie and McCarthy by two and one.

In the singles Tolley was beaten by McClelland by three and two. Hezlet beat Matthews by two and one. Pearson was beaten by Ogilvie by one hole, and Montmorency and McCarthy halved. Thus the tourists were beaten on the day's play by three games to two, with one halved.—Press Association Foreign Special.
