Harrison wins Cheshire boys' event

R. E. Harrison (Werneth Low) won the Cheshire boys' golf championship at Ringway yesterday with two rounds of 78. His total of 156 was two shots better than the holder, I. Bradshaw (Port Sunlight).

Harrison's success was adequate compensation for his failure in the recent East Cheshire boys' championship in which he was beaten after a tie with P. Horridge (Altrincham), who did badly yesterday. Bradshaw earlier had won the West Cheshire boys' championship and he failed to consolidate himself in his second round by taking 41 to the turn with an eight at the fifth, a severe jolt to him after he had completed the opening four holes in one under par.
